Method of Measurement: We will assess the number of plans and reports submitted by the original target completion date of December 1, 2023, and compare them to our total expected number of submissions (i.e., 45 out of 64 Plans and 41 out of 70 Reports). Quality Improvement Indicators: All in-progress course assessments will be offered one-toone support. Learning improvement discourse will be supported by asset-based comments. All content experts engaged with in-progress assessments will be guided through their 5-year schedule, discipline/program outcomes, and curriculum alignment maps.
