

1	•INITIAL REVIEW completed to review labor market data (demand, wage, growth), district interest, and area competition.
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2.	•WORKFORCE SOLUTIONS COUNCIL provides feedback on initial reveiws with high demand, wage and growth.
3.	•CORE TEAM (Deans, AVP, Workforce and Program Development) prioritizes programs to consider and identifies a faculty champion. Core team begins reaching out to industry in the district to confirm need and to begin identifying a future advisory council.
4.	•JOINT INSTRUCTIONAL COUNCIL (JIC) Core Team and faculty champion present potential programs to JIC for additional feedback.
5.	PROPOSAL sent to Executive Leadership Team (ELT) for approval.
6.	• DECISION
7.	•IMPLEMENTATION PROCESS begins after new program proposal is approved. Curriculum is developed in collaboration with a faculty champion or an industry subject matter expert.
