			<p>It was suggested that each of the GE requirements Physical/Life Science – Math -Communications – Social and Behavioral Sciences be assigned a primary ILO with choice on a second. Regarding The Global Awareness ILO, It was suggested that our Non-western and Diversity courses could work on aligning with this outcome.</p> <p>The response to this suggestion was that It is not accurate to assume that a particular ILO could be assessed in a particular course. More discussion is needed.</p> <p>There is an assumption that the various GE categories are probably already assessing the assumed ILO. Example Non-western and diversity courses most likely have already selected Global Awareness, Science courses may already be assessing Quantitate Literacy, etc. The council asked Evan to take a closer look at his data to see if we may already be assessing the in GE categories across disciplines.</p> <p>Implementing: It was mentioned that OAC faculty can help with choosing ILOs. It was suggested to send out a checklist during FDAE days. Heather mentioned that having the rubrics in front of her is helpful with assessing.
