EGR 100 Introduction to Engineering (1 lec/ 2 lab) 2 sem hrs

Effective date: Fall 2024

Summary of Changes: EGR 100 is a new course.

Rationale: EGR 100 Introduction to Engineering is being introduced as a result of reviewing student success in EGR 101 Engineering Graphics, which is a first-year transfer engineering course. It has been observed that students who come into the program without prior engineering coursework (i.e. CAD, EGR or PLTW - Project Lead the Way) are missing fundamentals that impact their success in the engineering pathway. This course will provide the necessary knowledge and skills needed prior to pursuing advanced coursework.

Impact: EGR 100 will be incorporated into the AES.

EGR 101 Engineering Graphics (2 lec/ 2 lab) 3 sem hrs

Effective date: Fall 2024

Summary of Changes: A recommended prerequisite EGR 100 is being added, course scheduling notes are being added, and ILOs are being updated.

Rationale: Course outline review to update the recommended prerequisite that incorporates the new EGR100 course.

Impact: This will be incorporated into the AES.

MLA 171 Medical Assistant Clinical I (2.5 lec/2 lab) 3.5 sem hrs

Effective date: Fall 2024

Summary of Changes: BIO 260 or concurrent and HIT 110 or concurrent are being removed from the enforced prerequisite and the ILOs are being updated.

Rationale: Due to the elimination of the PAX Exam, this is no longer a pathway to meet program requirements. HIT110 and BIO260 will now be required for admission into the MA program.
